

Růžová Hora by cable car, through the Herní krajina and hike back to Pec

Ride the cable car to Růžová hora from Pec, then head towards Děčínská boudu, which is the highest located dairy farm with original refreshments, until you reach Herní krajině Pecka. It's worth stopping there and resting. It's a beautiful place



and a large natural children's park where there is no entrance fee. After regaining your strength, you can continue on asphalt road towards Jana's chalet and further until you reach Pec. It's a less frequented route.













Jelení Louky for the best blueberry dumplings

From the hotel, walk up the asphalt road, past the playground, until you reach the turnoff to the Amor chalet. You could stop at this chalet for excellent ice cream and IPA beer. Then you can continue to Jelení Louky via a pleasant asphalt road.



You'll be driven by the prospect of the best blueberry dumplings in the area, a beautiful meadow for summer lounging, and a heated pool where visitors can also go if they buy entry at the bar.

The playground at Richterovy boudy and back

On this route, you'll definitely get a workout with a stroller. The ascent is steep, but the rewards include beautiful views from Richterovy boudy, stunning scenery, and asphalt road all the way.



Chapel in Obří Důl and back

🕒 2 hours 🛏 7 km

A gentle route through the Obří Důl along the Úpa River. Route goes around the bobsleigh track and ropeway park at the beginning. Then you can turn off the busy asphalt road slightly to the left and walk to the bottom station of the cable car where



are series of playful elements along the road. There is a large children's playground at the bottom station of the Sněžka cable car. Continue along the river, around the Bouda V Obřím Dole, where it is worth slowing down, around the Bouda Pod Sněžkou, where are llamas in a pen all the way up to the Chapel.





Vebrovy Boudy for draft Prosecco

(L) 3 hours - 8,5 km

The route leads from the hotel towards the slopes and then continues along the asphalt roud up the hill around Žižkovy Boudy, Husovy Boudy up to Pražská Bouda. The climb is rewarded with wonderful views and refreshing sparkling wine



in "Vebrovky". The route is asphalted with is little frequency of people.

"Bear's milk" in Severka

People used to visit Severka for bear's milk for ages. In recent years, however, the snack bar have been closed. This is the first season you can restore the tradition. We think Severka offers the most beautiful view of the Krkonoše Mountains. Do you agree?



Modrodolská Bouda for a beer

(L) 2 h → 6.1 km

Modrý důl is a unique area for its protected landscape where entry is forbidden most time of the year. However, hiking on the rout is open most time of the year. Take advantage of the time and go exploring. The road to Modrodolská Bouda is



paved or asphalted and gently steep. It is suitable for a walk with a stroller as well. You can also enjoy the walk in very hot summer days as the road goes through a wooded valley.
